- I. Devyn: First issue: how to run the convention-wide mystery game
 - a. Valerie: Base it off of the original clue game because working within a frame that exists makes it less confusing for participants and easier to plan
 - b. Original Game rules
 - i. 6 people, 6 rooms, 6 weapons; 21 total cards
 - c. Characters and Weapons (12 Olympians, maybe more if we need them)
 - i. Hades – Invisibility helmet
 - ii. Zeus – Lightning Bolt
 - iii. Aphrodite – Love Potion
 - iv. Apollo – Lyre
 - v. Hestia – Fire
 - vi. Poseidon – Trident
 - vii. Dionysus – Thyrsus
 - viii. Demeter – Cornucopia
 - ix. Hephaestus – Hammer
 - x. Artemis – Bow and Arrow
 - xi. Other ideas: Hera, Ares, Athena
 - d. Places (make longer and shorten depending on number of schools; trying to keep it myth based)

 - e. Procedure

- i. Each school will receive two cards and then in order to figure out the mystery, they will need to talk to other schools and the board members who will have cards
 - ii. Potentially: Information can be obtained by asking another school if a sequence of person-weapon-place is possible and the other school can respond with a yes/no and reason why it is not possible (have both parties sign the sheet)
 - iii. Potentially: Information can be traded (I have this weapon, what weapon do you have? Only one question per person, have them sign next to the trade)
 - iv. School can only give information about the cards they were originally given not what they have found out
 - v. Question: Can all delegates trade information or just school representatives? Most likely all to encourage mingling
 - f. Nicole will make the sheets to keep track of clues
 - g. We'll figure how many cards we get based on how many people go
 - h. Prize for the school that turns it in first; Tulsi needs to make it awesome
